The Security Infrastructure Program (SIP) is designed to help communities at risk of hate-motivated crime improve their security infrastructure.

Funding is available to non-profit organizations linked to a community at risk of being victimized by hate-motivated crime. The funds help with the costs of security infrastructure improvements for places of worship, provincially recognized educational institutions and community centres in communities at risk of hate-motivated crime.

Applicants not eligible for funding include Crown Corporations, public institutions, for-profit organizations and individuals.
