Road Closure of Markham between McNicoll Ave and Passmore Ave for Tamil Fest

on Aug. 26 to Aug. 28, inclusive. This 2nd Annual **Tamil Festival**, similar to other street festivals like Taste of Lawrence Taste of Asia and Taste of the Danforth, results in the temporary closure of this section of Markham Rd, and it becomes completely pedestrian-friendly. Running for the second year, the Tamil Festival brings together communities from all over Toronto to celebrate culture and diversity. There will be vendors, performances, kid's activities and much more. Festival goers are encouraged to take public transit as parking will be very limited.

Please exercise caution and use detour routes during the festival. Please be advised that the eastbound lanes on Passmore will be closed at Markham and the westbound lanes will be open. The 102 Markham buses will be diverted due to the closure – please watch out for TTC signage in the area.
