### **Red Light Camera Program Update**

The Red Light Camera Program has been operating since 1998 and the City has seen significant safety benefits at intersections where cameras are used. Five new Red Light Cameras will be installed at five signalized intersections in Ward 41 with selections based on a citywide review to identify locations with relatively high volumes of angle collisions. The list is as follows:

#### Scarborough-Rouge River (41) – New RLC Sites:

- 1. Brimley Rd at Finch Ave E
- 2. Finch Ave E at Middlefield Rd
- 3. Markham Rd at Sheppard Ave E
- 4. McCowan Rd at McNicoll Ave
- 5. McCowan Rd at Sheppard Ave E

Construction on these new sites has recently begun and will be completed between now and the end of the year. The aim is to have these sites ready and in full operation beginning 2017.

### **Metrolinx Regional Open Houses**

Metrolinx is holding open houses on key transit projects relevant to the community. This open house will include topics such as review of proposed mitigation strategies, feedback on environmental assessment (EA)/Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP) to build new track and electrification infrastructure, and review of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).
